

2017 WISCONSIN SPRING PREVIEW BEEF SHOW

Friday, June 2nd

12:00 pm: Animals may arrive by 12:00 p.m.—Barns will be locked until this time, do not arrive early!

Please note, no chutes will be allowed in the barns until after check/weigh in. Due to a very large show stalling will be very tight; take only the minimum space you need for your animals only. We ask that you leave no open stalls between you and your fellow exhibitors, so all animals will fit.

3:00 – 8:00 pm: Beef Weigh in-Check in

NEW IN 2017: In order to improve communication this year between the two beef rings, the WLBA will use RainedOut text messaging service to inform you about classes entering both rings. RainedOut delivers our alerts to you as a text message or email. There is no PA system on the grounds that services both of the show rings and barns, so we recommend subscribing to the free RainedOut service. Welcome Junior Beef Exhibitors to the 2017 Spring Preview Show!

Jefferson County Fair Park—503 N. Jackson Ave, Jefferson, WI 53549

- **No beef arrivals before 12:00 pm on Friday—Barns will be locked prior to this time! All beef must be in place by 8 pm on Friday, scales will close at 8 pm. Penning is on a first come-first basis—late arrival is not recommended.**
- **Due to large entry numbers there will be no chutes allowed in the barns until after check/weigh in. Please be considerate and take no more space than you need and please don't leave spaces between fellow exhibitors.**
- We will be showing in two rings; Herefords will show in the inside of the south end of the dairy barn....the same building they are stalled in. Angus exhibitors will be stalled in the beef barns and will show in the MAP building. All other exhibitors are encouraged to stall in the barn nearest your show ring—check your show schedule to see which ring you will show in.
- Please pick up your exhibitor number and show award sponsor sheet in the back of the Activity Center by 7:30 am on Saturday. Remember to wear your exhibitor number in the show ring.
- Anyone still owing membership or show fees must pay fees upon check-in Friday night.
- New WLBA T-shirts can be purchased at registration in the Activity Center. Our t-shirt theme this year is "Practice Like You've Never Won....Perform Like You've Never Lost!" T-shirts are black with Neon Green/Silver lettering.
- Angus and Hereford exhibitors will be checked in by their state breed association by the barn they are stalled in. All other exhibitors please check in at the station you are stalled nearest to.
- Commercial Heifers will be broken into classes by weight.
- Check tattoos against registration papers before you leave home. If a tattoo does not match a registration paper, the entry will be moved to the commercial division.
- All purebred steers need papers to show in the purebred division.
- Please bring your own bedding. **Bedding must be pushed 2 ft from the wall prior to your departure.**
- It is permissible to fit out of your trailers; **all bedding and debris should be raked and taken with you.**
- Exhibitors who have their own generators are encouraged to bring them to use outside of the barns.
- No active warts or ringworm are allowed on cattle, a veterinarian will be on the grounds to assist show staff.
- Exhibitors and their family members must fit their own cattle.
- Please unload and move your trailers as soon as possible as a courtesy to incoming exhibitors.

- There is camping allowed on the grounds, you will need to pre-pay for camping by calling the Jefferson Fair Park at 920/674-7148. The camping fee is \$30 per night. There are electrical hook-ups for campers and access to bathrooms/showers.
- We do not have a mass communication system between the barns and the ring. Classes will be posted late Friday night, all classes will be numbered—listen for your class number and please be on time for your class. Also, please see the NEW IN 2017 at the beginning of this document.
- Sue Finley from the Midwest Herdsman will be on site to take pictures of the WLBA champions as well as any other requested exhibitor photos.
- **All out of state exhibitors, please bring an additional copy of your health paper to be retained by our show chair.**
- **To our out of state Hereford exhibitors;** you must have an orange or silver metal tag, or an 840 RFID tag. There are a few other RFID tags that are allowed. **Breed tattoos and registration numbers are no longer acceptable.** You will not be allowed to show and will have to return home if you do not have proper ID on your health paper. Make sure your veterinarian is up to date with new regulations.
