Welcome Junior Swine Exhibitors to the 2017 Spring Preview Show!

- **Health Papers will be checked and pigs inspected before unloading. Exhibitors are required to bring their original health certificate PLUS a copy of their health certificate. Your original will be returned, the copy will be kept on file with the WLBA.** Contagious/infected hogs will not be allowed to unload.
- There will be an unloading area taped off for hog exhibitors behind the hog barn. Show staff will be present for health certificate and physical inspections.
- It is highly recommended that exhibitors practice proper biosecurity procedures prior to and after the show. Please disinfect your trailer and all equipment.
- Pens will be assigned for ONLY exhibitors who pre-entered by 5/26, please look for the posted penning chart prior to unloading. There may be some un-assigned pens available in the hog barn on a first come-first serve basis. Exhibitors entering 'day of show' should plan to show out of trailer unless a pen is available.
- WSPA exhibitors entering day of show should pay show fees and WLBA membership dues before check-in.
- 2017 WLBA t-shirts will be available in the Activity Center. This year's t-shirt theme is: "Practice Like You've Never Won....Perform Like You've Never Lost!" T-shirts are black with neon green/silver lettering.
- All pigs need to be checked and weighed in. Exhibitors will be responsible for getting their pigs to the scale to be weighed. Weight cards will be furnished for you prior to weigh in. Please list your name, your pig's breed, and ID. Cards should be given to show chair David Graff at the scale.
- Exhibitors showing purebred hogs should bring registration papers to the check-in table near the scales.
- Pens must be cleaned out before leaving the grounds—a \$25 per pen penalty will be assessed for pens left uncleaned. Bring a shovel and/or wheel barrow to speed up the clean-up process—the fair park does not provide these!
