Welcome Junior Beef Exhibitors to the 2014 Spring Preview Show!

Jefferson County Fair Park-503 N. Jackson Ave, Jefferson, WI 53549

- No beef arrivals before 12:00 pm on Friday—Barns will be locked prior to this time! All beef must be in place by 8 pm on Friday, scales will close at 8 pm.
- Due to large entry numbers there will be <u>no chutes allowed in the barns until after check/weigh in</u>. Please be considerate and take no more space than you need and please don't leave spaces between fellow exhibitors.
- We will be showing in two rings; Herefords will show in the warm-up arena, which is the building north of the hog barn. Hereford exhibitors will be stalled in the dairy barn, east of the warm-up arena. Angus exhibitors will be stalled in the beef barns and will show in the MAP building. All other exhibitors are encouraged to stall in the barn nearest your show ring—check your show schedule to see which ring you will show in.
- Please pick up your exhibitor number and show award sponsor sheet in the back of the Activity Center by 7:30 am on Saturday. Remember to wear your exhibitor number in the show ring.
- Anyone still owing membership or show fees must pay fees before weigh-in/check-in.
- New WLBA T-shirts can be purchased at registration in the Activity Center. Our t-shirt theme this year is "Champions Aren't Made in the Show Ring...they are Simply Recognized There!
- Angus and Hereford exhibitors will be checked in by their state breed association by the barn they are stalled in. All other exhibitors please check in at the station you are stalled nearest to.
- Commercial Heifers will be broken into classes by weight.
- Check tattoos against registration papers before you leave home. If a tattoo does not match a registration paper, the entry will be moved to the commercial division.
- All purebred steers need papers to show in the purebred division.
- Please bring your own bedding. All bedding must be pushed 2 ft from the wall prior to your departure.
- It is permissible to fit out of your trailers. <u>Clean up and rake your area before leaving</u>.
- Exhibitors who have their own generators are encouraged to bring them to use outside of the barns.
- No active warts or ringworm are allowed on cattle, a veterinarian will be on the grounds to assist show staff.
- For safety reasons, only use mounted fans. No butt fans are allowed.
- Exhibitors and their family members must fit their own cattle.
- Please unload and move your trailers as soon as possible as a courtesy to incoming exhibitors.
- There is camping allowed on the grounds, you will need to pay for camping with Jill Alf in the Activity Center. The camping fee is \$25 per night. There are electrical hook-ups for campers and access to bathrooms/showers.
- We do not have a mass communication system, all classes will be numbered—listen for your class number and please be on time for your class.
- Sue Finley from the Midwest Herdsman will be on site to take pictures of the WLBA champions as well as any other requested exhibitor photos.
- To our out of state Hereford exhibitors; there are some changes in the WI state rules! You must have an orange or silver metal tag, or an 840 RFID tag. There are a few other RFID tags that are allowed. <u>Breed tattoos and</u> registration numbers are no longer acceptable. You will not be allowed to show and have to return home if you do not have proper ID on your health paper. Make sure your veterinarian is up to date with new regulations.
