GOAT RULES:

- All trailers should enter gate #3 of the Fair Park. Do NOT arrive before 7:00 am.
- All species will be shown out of trailer. Penning is not available. All shavings, straw, or wool must be raked and disposed of before leaving. There will be a large dumpster on the grounds. Please bring your own rakes or necessary equipment to get it there, or take it home with you. We will be charged a fee if there are issues, and this will be passed on to the exhibitor in violation. Trailers leaving will be monitored by WLBA staff.
- All Goats must be checked in with show staff by 10:00 a.m. Any goats not checked in will not be eligible to show in either show.
- Market goat entries will be weighed at check-in.
- Up to 4 Market Wether goats may be shown per exhibitor—Meat Goats Only.
- Does & Bucks will be shown by age, starting with Spring doe kids
- Market Goats will be shown by weight. A scale will be available.
- Goats must be clipped and fit for show to participate.
- The WLBA has a zero-tolerance policy for exhibitors displaying any kind of unethical behavior at our event. Slapping or hitting animals in the show ring, the use of hot-shots, or any other behavior or actions deemed to be inhuman or unethical in nature will not be allowed. Disqualification may be considered.
