- There will be no penning allowed; all swine will show out of trailers. Trailer surrounds must be clean prior to leaving.
- Any day of show entry fees and membership dues must be paid BEFORE you check in.
- Enter early and get early-bird rates! Substitutions are allowed and entries do not have to be preidentified. Entries started in Showman App, but not paid for by the early entry deadline will not receive the discounted entry fee.
 - NEW in 2025: Jefferson County Fair Park has new regulations for livestock show parking. Please evaluate and print the fair park map provided <u>in color</u>. Parking of trailers in a colored campsite spot, anywhere on the fairgrounds will result in a daily fee of \$25 for a non-electric space, a fee of \$37 for a space w/electric, or \$47 for a space with both electric and sewer. If you want to park in these areas and ensure your reserved spot, please go to the Jefferson County Fairgrounds website at https://www.jcfairpark.com/p/camping/reservation to reserve and pay for a space. If you have questions, please contact the Jefferson Fair Park at 920-674-7148, open 8:00 am 4:30 pm, Monday-Friday. The WLBA office is NOT able to assist you with parking/camping reservations! Do not wait until your day of arrival to do this. Anyone who does not pre-register for a camping designated space and just parks their trailer in the spot upon arrival will be notified by park staff to pay or they could be subject to having to pack up and move if that spot has been pre-reserved by someone else. Parking at the fence around the outdoor arenas to the west where there is no water or electric hookup options is free. This area will be available on a first come, first serve basis. There will be no electricity, so bring your generators. Again, please see and print the map in color included with show information on the Showman App and decide where you would like to park prior to the show.
- Spring Preview is a WSPA sanctioned show, WSPA rules will be followed. Please go to the WSPA website for their 2025 rules: <u>https://www.wisconsinshowpigassociation.com/</u>
- All purebred and crossbred barrows and crossbred gilts must be weighed.
- Each exhibitor and or family must present a copy or original CVI prior to entering the grounds.

Swine moving within Wisconsin must have a CVI with the following:

1. Animal identification (USDA 840 button ear tag, county fair tag, or ear notch)

- 2. Statement (on CVI) that a veterinarian has inspected the entire herd of origin within the past 30 days before the show and that no apparent disease was present at the time of inspection. Statement must also include:
- 3. Farm of origin of has not had pseudorabies or swine dysentery in the past 12 months, has not had any clinical signs or diagnosis of TGE or PEDV in the past 60 days, feeds no garbage, uses no PRV vaccine, is not under quarantine for any disease condition and vesicular stomatitis has not been diagnosed within 10 miles of the farm of origin within the past 30 days.
 - a. <u>Testing for Porcine Reproductive and Respiratory Syndrome (PRRS) and Porcine</u> <u>Epidemic Diarrhea Virus (PEDv) is required as follows</u>:
 - If Negative tests of herd of origin within 90 days prior to movement, pigs can move to fairs or shows as noted above. Documentation of the negative test results must be made available upon request. Test results, test type, and date of testing need to be included on the CVI.
 - ii. If Positive tests for either PRRS or PEDv of herd of origin within 90 days prior to movement, the herd will be quarantined until a herd plan is established and approved. Swine may be able to move to the fair or show in accordance with the herd plan. Include the test results, test type, date of testing, and Herd Plan number on the CVI.
