- There will be no penning allowed; all swine will show out of trailers. Trailer surrounds must be clean prior to leaving.
- Enter early and get early-bird rates! **Substitutions are allowed and entries do not have to be pre-identified.** Entries started in Showman App, but not paid for by the early entry deadline will not receive the discounted entry fee. Your fees must be paid online by midnight of 6/4 to be considered a valid entry.
 - **PLEASE READ: Jefferson County Fair Park has specific regulations for livestock show parking. Please review and print the fair park map (in color) provided with the show information on the Showman App prior to arrival.** The fair park operates as a full campground, and any vehicles or trailers parked in designated camping sites are required to pay the standard fee. **All camping spaces must be reserved in advance through the fair park reservation system at <https://www.jcfairpark.com/p/camping/reservation> or by calling 920-674-7148 (Monday-Friday, 8:00 am – 4:30 pm).** Site dimensions and details are available online, and if one site does not accommodate your setup, multiple spaces must be reserved. Exhibitors who park in a designated camping space without a reservation will be required to pay the applicable fee or may be asked to move if the site has been reserved. Out of courtesy to seasonal campers, livestock is not permitted in the Full Hookup section (yellow sites). **Free trailer parking and dry camping (no water or electric) are available outside Gate 4 and around the outdoor arenas, as indicated in the circled areas on the map.** These areas are first come, first served, so please plan accordingly and bring generators if needed. Please note that the Activity Center parking lot may need to remain clear due to other events. **For questions regarding camping or parking reservations, please contact Jefferson County Fair Park directly at 920-674-7148, as the WLBA off cannot assist with these arrangements.**
- All purebred and crossbred barrows and crossbred gilts must be weighed.
- Each exhibitor and or family must present a copy or original CVI upon check-in. A copier may not be available, so please print a copy for the WLBA to retain per state movement regulations. If you do not bring a copy, your original copy may be retained.

Swine moving within Wisconsin must have a CVI with the following:

1. Animal identification (USDA 840 button ear tag, county fair tag, or ear notch)
2. All animals must have health papers and be individually identified on the CVI. All must include a statement that they are “free of diseases at time of inspection”. All health papers must include that the veterinarian has inspected the animal within 30 days of June 7, 2026.
